Reliability

Stuffing

While it is true that it's more effective to have additional stuffing, well-padded pet beds will not work for each and every dog. There are no cast in stone rules for this. You have to (once again) research the napping routines and determine whether your dog would like a pillowy mattress or a firmer one. Check whether your pet prefers sitting on the sofa, or plop on the hard floor. Small dogs usually like lush materials and downy beds, because they aren't likely to weigh much and squash the foam or anything like that. Then again, big dogs would like a more solid sleeping area to fully stretch.

Clean surroundings, a good amount of grub and also a warm home (literally and figuratively speaking) may help a lot.
